All over the world as well as India facing the effect of global warming, from last few decades, where major cities observed temperature, even up to 53 degree Celsius, which is nearly unbearable for human habitation and living creatures. It also contributed in the change of monsoon schedule and excess water and water required for agriculture affecting agriculture pattern and also increasing complicated health issues.



With the rapid growth of urbanization, people started flocking to the city. To provide accommodation to lakhs of people in the city housing complexes and high-rise buildings are constructed. It is not that all constructions are done following formal norms. This unplanned urbanization has given rise to several environmental issues, deforestation, excess use of groundwater, air and water pollution and several others. People living in the slums of the city are using wood and coal, increasing carbon dioxide in the air. Gradual change of climate in the urban scenario developed environmental crisis, e.g. global warming, water scarcity etc.

To come out from this adverse situation it is already late to think for overcoming this situation. Senior researchers have warned us years ago that the entire world is going to face these challenges and we have to become more cautious of using natural resources which also includes environment conservation. This, will not only save human civilization but also the natural habitat including flora and fauna.

Engaging the community people in the movement is considered for broad-based intervention where each and every people of the community will be sensitized enough for their own survival, not only for the human being, but also other living creatures of this ecosystem. Besides drastic climate change, change in the pattern of soil, particularly large section of the agricultural land which feeding the people of the country is at stake. Change in the coastal pattern. Rise in the sea level of water, intrusion of saline water in the main land, abrupt increase in the salinity of the soil left a great impact on the livelihood pattern and also on the natural habitation both in rural and urban areas. Since last few years, Kolkata and suburbs including districts of south West Bengal are burning from the heat and gradually it increases every year during the month of April to June.

In this context Right Track has decided engagement of youths / students as a strategic plan to deal with the issue of environment conservation at the local level. It is because a group of sensitized and educated people will take lead role in mobilizing larger

group of population who will be aware and responsible while using natural resources. Stakeholders at different level will also be sensitized who will influence the policymakers to in formulating environment friendly planning for development of the country towards building climate resilient communities.

**Program details:**

Right Track, in collaboration with Govt. Girls General Degree College (GGGDC), initiated the **"Better Environment - Better Tomorrow"** Program with the primary objective of addressing the urgent challenges posed by climate change and global warming. Recognizing the critical need for immediate action, the program was designed to educate and involve college students. This included participation of **200** college students, local community representatives, and local key stakeholders such as local ward councillors, teachers of school & colleges invested in environmental conservation. By fostering awareness and engagement among these groups, the initiative sought to empower individuals with the knowledge and motivation to contribute effectively towards mitigating environmental degradation and fostering sustainable practices.

Different types of events were scheduled throughout the day such as inauguration ceremony, Workshop, Wall painting activity, sapling plantation & certification.

**Inauguration Ceremony:** The Program commenced with an inauguration ceremony attended by college students, professors, college principal, local community leaders, and esteemed guests. Honourable guests delivered insightful speeches highlighting the importance of environmental conservation in combating climate change. **Prof. Debaprasad Banerjee** from GGGDC articulated in his inaugural speech, "It is imperative that we all commit ourselves, especially the younger generation, to assume responsibility for the preservation of our environment." **Md. Ashraf Ali**, Hony. General Secretary of Right Track, underscored, "We acknowledge our responsibility for the current environmental challenges and are dedicated to taking proactive measures to address and mitigate these issues." Social activist **Md. Izhar Alam** stressed the urgency "to eradicate plastics and curb the misuse of water." **Dr. Syeda Sharikatul Mousa Alquadr**, Principal, GGGDC expressed gratitude to Right Track for initiating such valuable programs and expressed optimism about future collaborations for similar initiatives. Upon completion of the

guest speech, the college students welcomed the guest by presenting saplings to them.

**Workshop Program:**

An workshop was organized where **30** students participated. There was a presentation by Mr. Krishanu Bhattacharya & Ms. Aditi Roy Chowdhury on waste management strategies. They detailed about different types of wastes in our daily life and how they can be managed properly. Then Different types of cost effective and health friendly waste management techniques were discussed. The initiatives of municipal bodies in waste management policies were also discussed. The next session was about the understanding of environment and how environment can be protected in several ways, facilitated by Mr. Subir sen from Right Track. After showing a video document a group activity was conducted where participants were encouraged to share their views about environment and how we can protect our environment for making it conducive for habitation. In the workshop students explored several ideas noted it in chart papers and presented in several groups. **30** students divided in six groups presented their understanding about environment and strategies of environment protection where it was observed that each group of has almost similar perception about environment and they shared different traditional as well as innovative strategies where life on earth can be more pleasant and sustainable.



At the end of the workshop students were enthusiastic in having such kind of thought provoking workshops which besides their regular academic curriculum give them ample opportunity to delve in the world of different social issues.
