



# *Report on NSS 7-Day Special Camp*

**Day 6 (22.03.2025)**

**Activities**

On the 6<sup>th</sup> day of 7-Day camp, the NSS Unit-I of GGGDC went to visit Calcutta National Cancer Institute (CNCI) and there they provided some voluntary services. First the NSS volunteers met with the chief matron of CNCI and under her supervision they helped the family members of the patients by guiding them how to apply to get permission for night stay. Then the volunteers were taken to different wards and outdoor in the hospital. The volunteers also interacted with the social welfare officer and got to know about the various facilities that are available for the patients and their family members during the treatment of cancer in CNCI. The chief matron also guided the volunteers about how to self examine for breast cancer. In future, the volunteers will spread all these knowledge that they gathered from CNCI in their community.

Finally, the volunteers visited the laboratory of Dr.Arпита Banerjee, Senior Scientific Officer who inspired the students to research on medicine of cancer to help the community.
