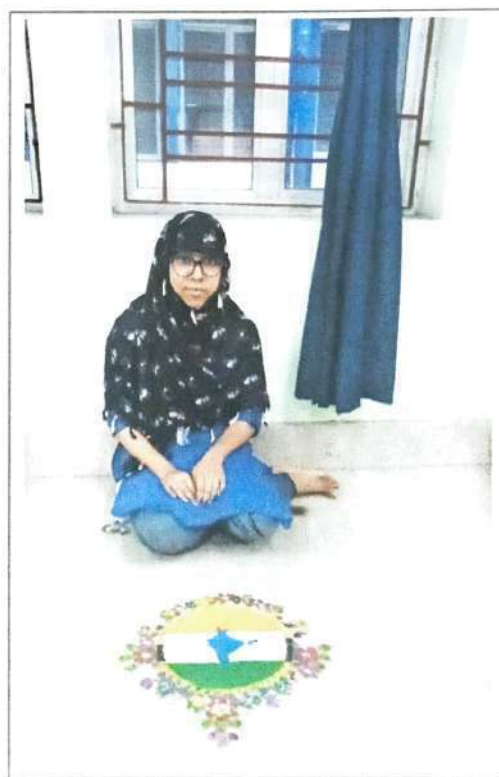

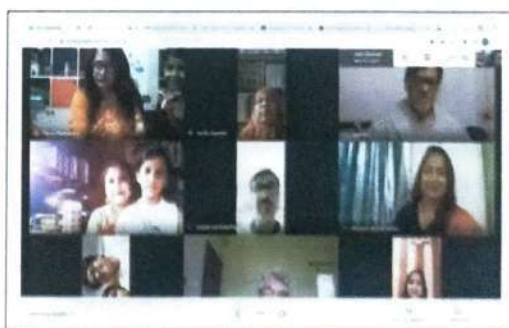
Independence Day Celebration, 2020

Kidderpore college students, teachers uphold unity in food diversity with traditional dishes

Kolkata: The Government Girls' General Degree College in Ekbalpur hosted a heritage food festival — Khana — Kidderpore — on Tuesday to celebrate the gastronomical plurality of the area, which ranged from Assam, Bihar to local Bengali and Anglo-Indian cuisines. It is through food that the college is trying to showcase the rich socio-cultural diversity of the neighbourhood and build bridges between the communities. The event was held on the occasion of World Heritage Week in collaboration with the West Bengal Heritage Commission, Intech, Kona Your Neighbour and Break Five Trails.

The college invited some of the old eateries of the neighbourhood like Young Bengal Hotel, Deepali Canteen, Ganga Kebab Centre, Kanon's to put up their stalls at the event. The visitors were seen tucking into fish chow, vegetable chaps, ghaint,

"Many in Kolkata associate the Kidderpore area, including Ekbalpur, Mominpur and Shehabpur with only biryani and kebabs but there are old joints selling Bengali traditional dishes. The neighbourhood is awash of bhoswa puri, mowca lakda, min khanta, bak-bak-chani, fish fry, dhokla, dal vada, bache-bi and German bread. These di-

verse cuisines not only focus on the rich intangible heritage of the area but also highlight the social diversity which is often overshadowed by stereotypical mindsets nurtured through pre-conceived notions," said Antara Mukherjee, assistant professor of English at the college and the brain behind the festival.

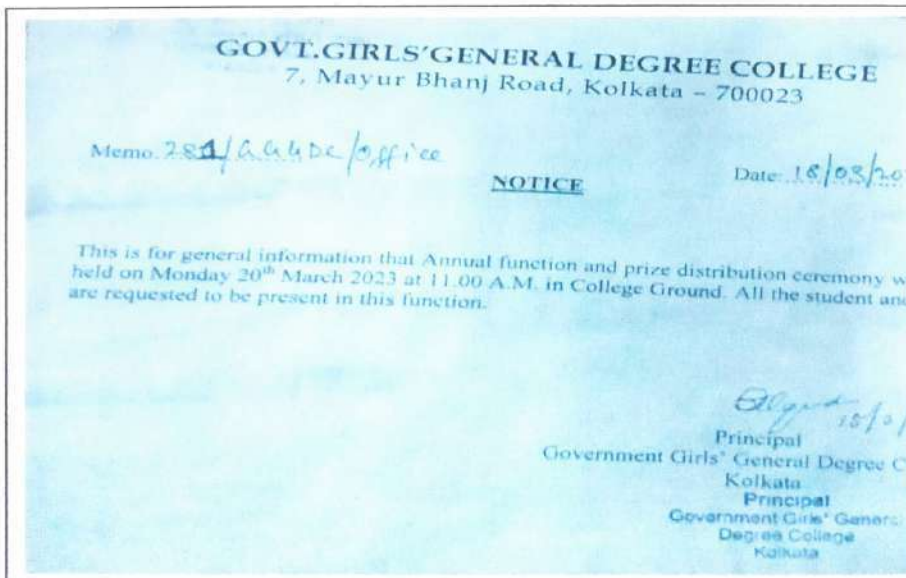

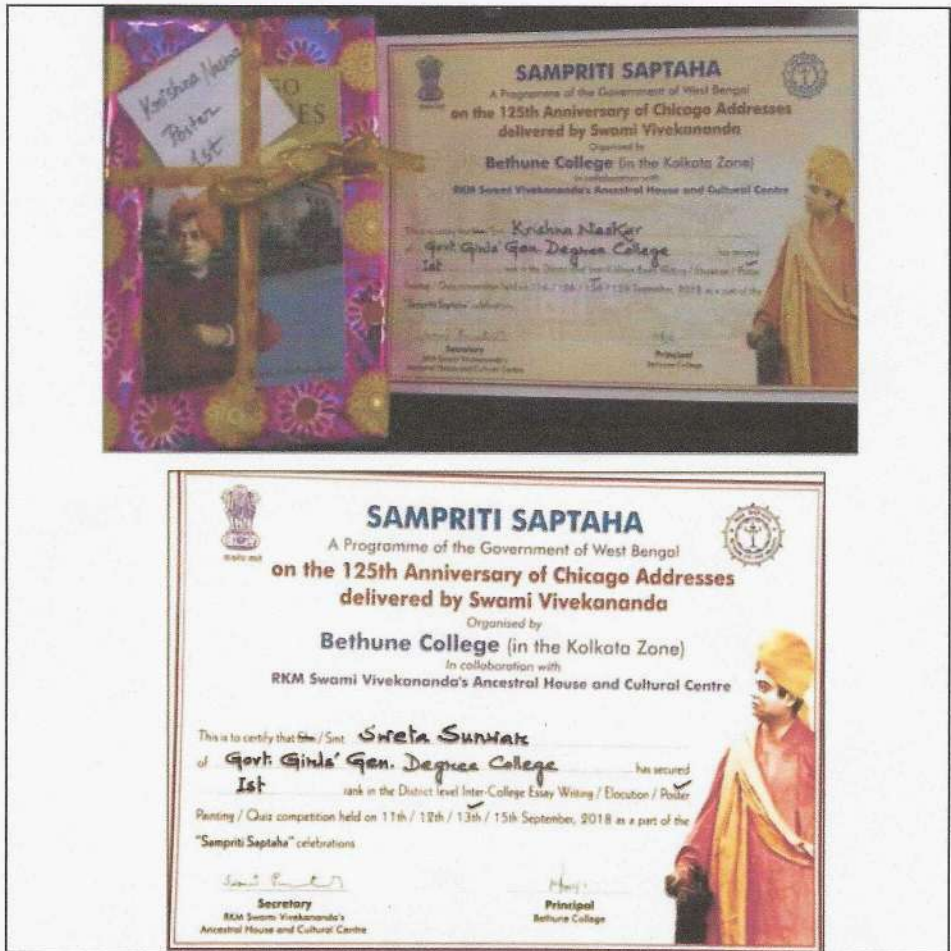

পাশাপাশি কোনও দেশ অর্থনৈতিকভাবে ক্ষতির মুখে পড়ত না। তাঁর পরামর্শ, বিশ্ব শান্তি আনতে এবং বিশ্বকে অস্থায়ী, পরমাণু বোমা মুক্ত করতে এক দেশের সঙ্গে অন্য দেশের শান্তিচুক্তি খুবই জরুরি। শুধু সামাজিক, অর্থনৈতিক অধিকাংশের উপরই নয়, ধর্মের উপর আঘাত হানলেও যুদ্ধ তৈরির সম্ভাবনা থাকে। দৃষ্টান্ত উল্লেখ করে রুবাইয়া বলেন, কুরআনে যে সমস্ত আয়াত ও সূরা রয়েছে, সেখানে শান্তি প্রতিষ্ঠার কথা বলা হয়েছে। শান্তির লক্ষ্যে যে সুরাগুলি আল কুরআনে উল্লেখ করা হয়েছে, সেগুলি মানুষের কাছে পৌঁছানো জরুরি। সোশ্যাল মিডিয়ায় মাধ্যমে কোনও মূল বিষয়কে বিকৃত করাও কোনওভাবে কামা নয়। এতে বিভ্রম তৈরি হয়। আর তা পরবর্তীতে যুদ্ধ বা অশান্তি তৈরিতে সহায়তা করে। যুদ্ধ তৈরির মূল লক্ষ্য ক্ষমতা অর্জন। তাই শক্তি অর্জনের রাজনীতি খুবই গুরুত্বপূর্ণ ভূমিকা পালন করে। কোনও দেশ শক্তি অর্জনের রাজনীতিতে কাঁপিয়ে পড়লে এবং পালটা বাধার সৃষ্টি হলে যুদ্ধ হয়। আর এতে নিরপরাধ মানুষের প্রাণহানি হয়।

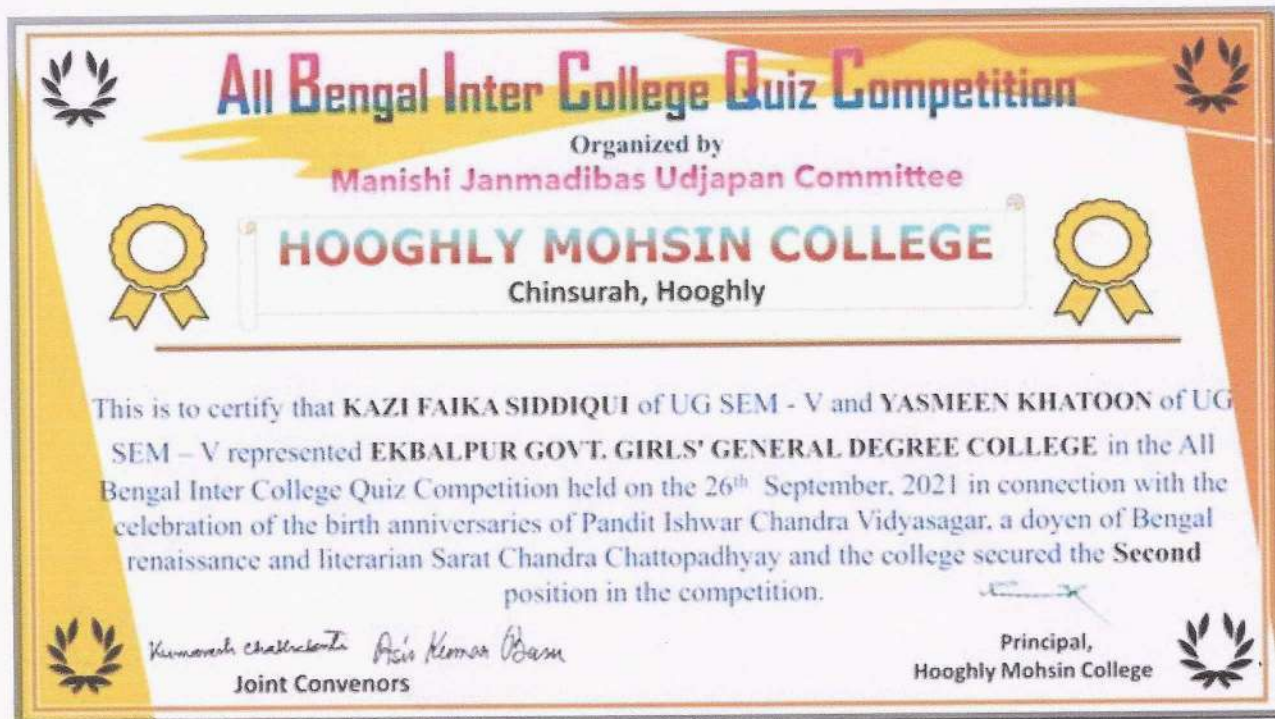

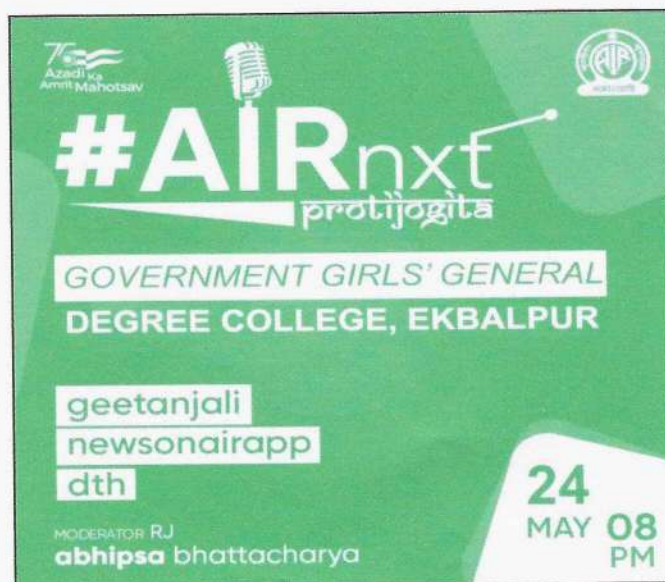


Event 2
