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

Welcome to the online course – An advanced course on pulsar astrophysics. The course is based on a series of 20 lectures given by Professor Dipankar Bhattacharya at NCRA in 2018. The recordings of those lectures will be made available through our course portal at <http://www.mrciucaa.in> and also through our YouTube channel 'MRC IJCAA' <https://www.youtube.com/channel/UC6A...>. This course assumes a fairly sound background of physics and astrophysics and familiarity with neutron stars. Although it will provide some introductory context, the bulk of the lectures will be devoted to discussing theoretical models and simulations of the pulsar magnetosphere, high-energy and radio emission processes and models for pulsars, and neutron star interiors. A more detailed list of lecture topics and the constituent sub-topics is appended below.

As participants, your weekly engagement with this course will involve the following:

  - Posting questions in the discussion forums in the course portal.
